

National Education Act (amendment no. 17) (2018)¹

Amendment to article 2

1. In National Education Law - 1953² – article 2 –

(1) The content of which will be referred to as (a), and after which will read:

"(13) to educate towards meaningful service in the Israel Defense Forces or national-civilian service as defined in the National-Civilian Service Law, 2014³;

(2) After sub-article (a) will read:

"(b) the minister will determine rules to prohibit activity in educational institutions of persons or bodies that are not part of the education system (in this sub-article – external entities) whose activity severely and grossly contradicts the objectives of the National Education as specified in sub-article (a), and rules to prevent activity in an educational institution of an external entity that actively promotes legal or diplomatic actions to be taken outside Israel against soldiers of the Israel Defense Forces for an act they have committed in the framework of their service or against the State of Israel."
